Introduction

Philip Colbert works in a wildly exuberant aesthetic that updates the legacy of collage for the internet age. Colbert's oil paintings challenge and toy with the viewer's cultural vocabulary - superimposing commonplace banal objects onto painted faces and merging portraiture with popular culture in a Magritte-like fashion. Colbert's hyper technicolour canvases are packed with a gallimaufry of contemporary iconography.
